The Old School House

Former school sold in Compton Chamberlayne.

The Old School House which is set back from the High Street in the delightful village of Compton Chamberlayne has recently been sold by McKillop & Gregory. It has attractive sand stone elevations beneath a tiled roof and was originally constructed in the 19th Century as the local school when the roll numbered 38 children with the school closing in 1933. It has particularly attractive accommodation with numerous original features including mullion windows, yew windowsills, open fireplaces and exposed timbers. The accommodation which is versatile in its layout includes a sitting room, kitchen, dining room, study, lobby with cloak/shower room, principal bedroom with dressing room and en-suite bathroom and two further bedrooms. The property is approached by a long drive and it has an attractive garden which backs onto parkland. The asking price was £500,000.
