Drake	Percy Albert	<p style="text-align: center;">In loving memory of 2nd Lieut. PERCY ALBERT DRALE of the 13th Battalion Gloucester Regiment who fell in action in France, October 13th 1916, Aged 26 years. Also of Corporal Vivian Drake of the 6th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment who fell in action in France, July 7th 1916.
