**1860**

August 4th at Cooper's Hall Baptist Chapel, Bristol by the Rev. James Davis, Mr. John Porter of Seend, to Sarah second daughter of Mr. W. King of Corsham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 9 August 1860**

**1861**

June 3rd at Corsham, by the Rev. R G. Swayne, cousin of the bride, Henry Banks Spencer, esq, MD, eldest son of the late Henry Spencer, esq of Chippenham, to Mary Anne, daughter of the Rev. George Mullins, Rector of Great Chalfield. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 10 January 1861**

**1864**

On the 28th February 1864, at his residence, Rose Villa, Corsham, Wilts, Mr. George White, England, aged 78. The deceased was a native of Devizes, and for many years carried on the business of confectioner in that town. Brother to Mr. Laban White, coroner, Windsor. **Unknown Australian Newspaper, 1864**

**1866**

On the 25th July 1866, at Lowbourne Bridge, Melksham, Wilts, at the residence of her brother, Mr. William White, Miss Mary White, a native and for many years an inhabitant of Devizes, and late of Corsham, in her 82nd year, and sister of Mr. L. White, of Windsor. **Unknown Australian Newspaper, 1866**

**1870**

January 24, at Corsham, Mr. James Bromley, aged 56. **Devizes Advertiser, Thursday, 3 February 1870**

**1873**

December 18th, at Corsham, Wilts, J. J. H. Cole, only son of Jeremiah Isaac and Ellen Maria Cole of Lenton, Great Chalfield, Wiltshire, aged 8 years 11 months. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 25 December 1873**

**1878**

July 7, at Pond Close, Corsham, the wife of Mr. Josiah Pocock, of a son. **Swindon Advertiser, 13 July 1878**

**1888**

January 15th Pickwick, Corsham, the wife of Thomas Pearman Stevens, of a son. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 19 January 1888**

June 16, at St. Andrew's, Walcot, Bath, by the Rev. Francis E. Murphy, Henry Williams, of Bishopston (Gloucestershire). and Chippenham, to Maude Ruth, youngest daughter of the late John Compton Law, of Corsham. **Trowbridge Chronicle, 23 June 1888**

**1892**

Died July 14, at Garfield Villas, Station Road, Corsham, Henry Hore, aged 75. **Wiltshire Times, 30 July 1892**
