Theft of 1½d from till. Warminster Police Court, Saturday. Before Mr G.L. Lopes, Captain Southey, and the Rev. W. Hickman. John Balch, a tramp, was charged with stealing 1 ½ d , from a till belonging to William John Eyers, of Chapmanslade. Prisoner admitted the theft, and was committed to trial at the next Quarter Sessions. **Western Gazette, 25 May 1888**
