Theft of clothes Warminster Police Court, Saturday. Before Mr G.L. Lopes, Captain Southey, and the Rev. W. Hickman. Thomas Belcher was charged with stealing a coat, waistcoat, pair of trousers, and two shirts, the property of James Barnes, of Corsley. It appeared that the articles were hung on some rails outside the house, from which they were taken by defendant, who pleaded guilty, and was committed to take his trial at the next Wilts Quarter Sessions. **Western Gazette, 25 May 1888**
