Hickman.Thomas Belcher was charged with stealing a coat, waistcoat, pair oftrousers, and two shirts, the property of James Barnes, of Corsley.It appeared that the articles werehung on some rails outside the house, from which they were taken by defendant, who pleaded guilty, andwas committed to take his trial at the next Wilts Quarter Sessions.Western Gazette, 25 May 1888
