**Westbury Petty Sessions – Monday 12th September 1864 –** Before H G G Ludlow, Chas Phiips and A. Laverton Esq.

John Culverhouse of Chapmanslade, an idle lazy rascal, was brought up in custody, charged with obstructing the thoroughfare, on Sundays, by lolling with others (already fined) about the entrance to the Chapel, thereby causing a nuisance. Ordered into custody till 8s 6d, expenses, were paid. The offense has been the cause of much annoyance to frequenters of places of worship in that village for some time.
