

## Post Office Directory Extract 1855 East Coulston



**EAST COULSTON** is a township and small parish, situate 5¾ miles north-east of Westbury, 21 north-east of Salisbury, and 7½ south-west of Devizes, in the Hundred of Whorwelsdown, and in Salisbury bishopric. The living is a rectory, and the Rev. John Charles Clapp, M.A., is the rector. The church is very small, and has a low spire rising from the north end, which contains I bell. The population, in 1851, was 101, and the area of acres 868, which are principally arable.
