



Cricklade St. Sampson's Churchyard Burial Plot Details

This first part of this list was compiled from a manuscript record of monumental inscriptions CRDWH#312 made by TTR-B in 1959. For ease of use the following transcriptions excludes religious texts, etc., and contains only the important data.

Entries marked \S refer to monuments in St. Sampson's which were listed by Rev. T. H. Baker in 1880, but many of them no longer existed, or were illegible in 1959.

Some ten years after the above M.S. was written, the churchyard was taken over by Cricklade Town Council who removed many monuments which were deemed to be in a dangerous condition.

The numbers in the left- hand column correspond to numbers on a plan of the church and churchyard which shows their locations.

Some monuments in the church which are obscured by pews and the organ have not been listed.

Dates are those of death unless otherwise stated.

Numbers in round (brackets) refer to family pedigrees.

Numbers in square [brackets] are notes added by the compiler.

Unless otherwise stated, ages are in years e.g., aged 36 years.
