In the Name of God Amen I William Quarrell of the Parish of Cricklade Saint Sampson in the County of Wilts Yeoman being of sound mind memory and reson and calling to mind the Mortality of my body do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) I desire that all my just debts and funeral expences be first paid and discharged by my Executor hereinafter named I give and bequeath my Real and Personal Estate amongst my Sons and Daughters share and share alike (that is to say) my Son John Quarrell Samuel Quarrell Ann Rew Mary Part and I give and bequeath the share of my daughter Jane Crowther deceased to her children to be divided among them share and share alike and I give to William Ball the son of my daughter Elizabeth Ball deceased the share equal to the rest of

my Sons and Daughters to be put out to Interest by my Executor in trust till he shall attain to the age of twenty one years And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Joseph Ralph Mullins Esqr of Cirencester in the County of Gloucester sole Executor in Trust of this my last Will and Testament In Witness hereunto I the said William Quarrel the Testator hath to this my last Will and Testament contained in one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of June in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Part the sum of Twenty pound extra over and above the rest of my children for her attendance on me in my illness the Mark X of William Quarrell
