The Rev. E.J. Phipps having stated that the early hour at which they met was at present inconvenient to him, wished to know whether their meetings could not be held in the evenings.

Mr. White said he could by think it extraordinary that Mr. Phipps, who had on a former occasion so feelingly objected to the expense of fires, should now wish to incur an additional expense for candles.

The Meeting was then adjourned till Monday, the 26th, and the hour fixed at 12, instead of 11, for the accommodation of Mr. Phipps.
