Inquest --- At Totterdown, Seend, on Tuesday before Mr F T Sylvester, coroner for Mid -Wilts, on the body of Charles Gumm who shot himself close to the Devizes and Melksham high road on the previous day. Deceased's mother stated that her son had lately been suffering from the heat, and Dr Keir said this might have affected the man's brain. The jury returned a verdict of suicide whilst of unsound mind.
