Cole at Alverstoke, Hampshire in 1865. Is listed in the 1891 census as Sergeant at Mace, and in 1901 as an RMLI pensioner. He died at Devizes in 1906.
1911	1915	Frost	John	1855		Tockington, Gloucestershire	He married Lucy Ann Nash at Bristol in 1876. In the 1881 census is listed as a Corn Porter at New Park St., in 1891 as a Boiler Maker at Wharf St. and in 1901 and 1911 as a House Painter at Sheep St. He died at Devizes in 1921.

Married Catherine Woodruff at Devizes in 1855 and after she died in 1881, he married Hester Jane Pearce at Devizes in January 1901. Listed as a Tinman and widower in the census of 1881 and 1891 at Sheep Street, and a Coppersmith at Sidmouth St. in 1901. He died at Devizes early in 1909.

1911	1916	Woodruff	Thomas	1847		Bishops Cannings	Son of George and Emma Woodruff. In the 1881 census he is listed as unmarried, working as a bricklayer's labourer, but in April 1886 he married Ann Bolland at Devizes. By 1901 he was still working as a bricklayer's labourer at St John St. He died at Devizes in 1922. See also list of Bill Posters
