



Charged With Not Having A Weighing Machine

The Monthly Petty Session was held at the Town Hall, Westbury, on Monday, before Mr. W. H. Laverton (chairman) and Mr. F. W. Laverton. Albert Bailey (14) of Dilton Marsh was summoned at the instance of the Inspector of Weights and Measures for having, on 24th June, in the parish of Dilton Marsh, unlawfully delivered from a vehicle drawn by a horse, coal in quantities not exceeding 2 cwt. without carrying a weighing instrument approved and stamped by the Inspector of Weights and Measures. Defendant pleaded guilty and was fined £1 including costs.....

Fred Jones, coal dealer, of Dilton Marsh, was summoned for a like offence at Dilton Marsh on June 24th. Fined £2 to include costs.
