Diamond Jubilee of Holy Trinity Church.

The Celebration of the Jubilee of Holy Trinity Church has been commemorated during the last few days commencing on Sunday with a harvest thanksgiving service. The Rev Canon Jacob R.D. preached at Matins, and the Vicar (the Rev O.H. Wilson) at evensong, where the offerings were in aid of hospitals. On Tuesday a dinner was given to every widow in the parish over 60 years of age, and in the evening a service was held, were the sermon was preached by Rev Wynn Lloyd. On Wednesday all the children of the Day and Sunday schools were given a tea. Athletic sports were held yesterday, in connection with the Jubilee in a field tent lent by Mr C.N.P. Phipps, following which the Jubilee service was held in the Church with a sermon by Rev W. C. Browne. A large number sat down to a public tea subsequently held, followed by speeches and music. The meetings have been a great success.
