



Bequest for the Poor

Monday, July 2, 1787 –

"On Monday last died at Tadcaster in Yorkshire, Edward Whatmore, Esquire, of Marshwood, near this city".

Monday, August 6, 1787 –

"The late Mr Whatmore of Marshwood left five guineas to the town of Wilton and the same sum to the parish of Dinton, to be given to the poor in bread at the rate of one guinea a Sunday".
