APPOINTMENTS

PREFERRED – The Rev. Mr William Dean B.D. to the living of Dinton in Wilts.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal - Monday 20 March, 1775)

The valuable living of Dinton, in this county, now void by the death of Henry Linton, D.D., is in the patronage of the President and Fellows of Magdalen College, in the University of Oxford. The deceased was formerly a fellow of the College, and it is supposed the senior fellow will now be presented to the living.



On the 9th inst., the Rev. James Charles Stafford, clerk, B.D., Fellow of Saint Mary Magdalen College, was instituted by the Lord Bishop of this Diocese to the Vicarage of Dinton, in this county, void by the death of Henry Linton, D.D., on the presentation of the President and Scholars of Saint Mary Magdalen, College, in the University of Oxford.
