SAD FATE OF AN AGED WOMAN.- An inquest was held by Mr Wilson at the Salisbury Infirmary, on Friday, on the body of Ann Bishop, aged 78 years, who died on Thursday from the effects of burns received from falling into the fire in her cottage at Dinton on the 15th inst. The deceased was alone at the time the accident occurred, but she told a neighbor that she fell into the fire whilst attempting to take off the tea-kettle.
