## Henry & John Lampard 8<sup>th</sup> July, 1839

Mr Whitmarsh held an inquest on Monday at the French Horn, near Dinton, on the body of Henry Lampard, aged 24 years and John Lampard, 19 years. It appeared in evidence, that on the day previous, about 11 o'clock in the morning, these unfortunate young men left the above inn and proceeded to Morris' hatches close by, for the purpose of bathing; when, having very incautiously ventured out of their depth, they were shortly afterwards drowned.

Verdict in both cases, Accidental
