

Dinton - Dalwood Letters

'Spye Park'. 29th July 1848.

My dear Margaret,

.....

Ireland is in a state of rebellion, and the Habeas Corpus Act has been suspended there. It is thought that the people have been so inflamed by the would-be Kings of Ireland that some bloodshed must take place before all settles down quietly once more. Strong measures are now being taken by Government to put down the clubs and other disloyal meetings, and I trust in a little time we shall all be quiet again.
