DINTON is a village, railway station and parish, in the Southern division of the county, hundred of Warminster, Wilton Union, Salisbury county court district, diocese and archdeaconry, and Chalke rural deanery, 8 miles west from Salisbury station, 92 from London by South Western Railway, 7 east from Hindon and 5 ½ west from Wilton, situated on the river Nadder.

It is known as the birth-place of the celebrated Lord Clarendon.

The church of St Mary, which is in the Transition Norman, Early English, Perpendicular and Decorated styles, is built in the form of a cross, having nave, chancel, and transepts, with a square embattled tower rising from the centre, with 6 fine-toned bells. The register dates from 1558.

Dinton House is the seat of William Wyndham, Esq J.P., The Earl of Pembroke (who is lord of the manor) and W. Wyndham, Esq are the principal landowners. The kennels of the South Wilts fox-hounds are here.

The soil is clay, chalk and green sand; subsoil same; many of the meadows are irrigated. The chief crops are wheat, barley, hay and apples; a good deal of cider is made; there is also much dairy farming, butter and cheese are made, and milk is sent to the London market.

The population in 1861 was 509.
