On Saturday night, the 18th inst., the stable of Mr Compton, of Barford Mill, was entered, and a bridle and saddle and a small quantity of horse corn were stolen therefrom.- On the same night, stable of Mr King, of Dinton, was entered, and a quantity of harness was cut and very much damaged, but not taken away.
