Listed below is a short biography of those brave souls who gave their lives for their country during WWI and are in some way connected to Donhead St. Andrew

**FOWLER, CECIL DASHWOOD MILMAN** - Lieutenant - The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment) Died 25th September 1915 - Age 18 - Son Lieutenant-Colonel V. A. Fowler and Edith Marian Fowler of Donhead Lodge, Donhead St. Andrew - Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panel 13 to 15. Commemorated on the Loos Memorial - Panel 13 to 15. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**HAIME, FRANCIS (FRANK) GEORGE** - 5th Battalion Queens Royal West Surrey Regiment - Died 3rd May 1917 - Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew

**HEAD, REGINALD CHARLES JOHN** - Rifleman TR/13/14596 - 19th Battalion, King's Royal Rifle Corps - Died 8th April 1917 - Age 18 - Born in Donhead St. Mary; Resident of Donhead St. Mary; Enlisted at Chelsea, Middlesex - Buried in Donhead St. Andrew Cemetery, Lower Street, Donhead St. Andrew - Grave/Memorial Reference:- North West Part. Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**HILL, NICHOLAS WEATHERBY (MC)** - Captain - 2nd Battalion, Oxford and Bucks Light Infantry - Died 16th January 1917 - Age 20 - Born in Weeke, Winchester, Hampshire; Son of Henry L. G. and Mary Hill of Donhead Cottage, Donhead St. Andrew; Scholar of Winchester College and New College, Oxford - Buried at Courcellette British Cemetery, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- I. D. 13.

**HILL, PERCIVAL HENRY** - Corporal 16355 - 8th Battalion, East Yorkshire Regiment - Died 31st March 1916 - Age 21 - Born in East Knoyle; Enlisted at Oakham, Hampshire; Son of John Henry and Elizabeth Ann Hill of 78 Parkstone Avenue, Parkstone, Dorset - Commemorated on the Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, Ieper, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panel 21 and 31. Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**HILL, WALTER GEOFFREY** - Private 10920 - 3rd Battalion Coldstream Guards - Died 15th September 1916; Born in East Knoyle; Enlisted at Salisbury - Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Pier and Face 7D. and 8D. Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew.

**KING, ERNEST HENRY** - Private 20694 - 14th Battalion Gloucestershire Regiment - Died 1st November 1917 - Born in Donhead St. Andrew; Enlisted at Tisbury - Buried in Canada Farm Cemetery, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- III. F. 14. Commemorated on

the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**LAWES, ERNEST HENRY** - Private 30249 - 2nd Battalion, Oxford and Bucks Light Infantry - Died 1st October 1918 - Age 19 - Born in Donhead St. Andrew; Resident of Donhead St. Andrew; Enlisted at Reading, Berkshire; Son of Henry and Julia Lawes of West End, Donhead St. Andrew. - Killed in Action at Cambrai. - Buried at Anneux British Cemetery, Nord, France - Grave Reference III. D. 17. Commemorated on Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew

**LITTON, WILLIAM GEORGE** - 1914-1918 - Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**PUIG, GEORGE CHARLES** - Shoeing Smith TS/9451 - 854th Horse Transport Company, Army Service Corps - Died 24th October 1918 of pneumonia - Age 28 - Born in Marylebone, London; Resident of Salisbury; Enlisted at Bournemouth, Dorset; Son of Henry and Jane Ann Puig of Overway, Donhead St. Andrew - Buried at Mikra British Cemetery, Kalamaria, Greece - Grave/Memorial Reference:- 1690. Commemorated on Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral (listed as G. Pugh)

**SIMMONDS, ALFRED GEORGE** - 1914-1918 - Commemorated on the Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew. Named in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

**SLADE, ROBERT BISHOP** - Lieutenant - Royal Air Force - Died 23rd July 1918 - Age 26 - Son of Leonard Gillott and Maria Slade of Park Gate Farm, Donhead St. Andrew - Buried at Aston Upthorpe (All Saints) Churchyard, Aston Upthorpe, Berkshire - Grave/Memorial Reference:- None Recorded.

**WELLSTEAD, HERBERT JOSEPH** - Driver L/46669 - 33rd Division, Ammunition Column, Royal Field Artillery. - Died 20th October 1918 of influenza and pneumonia - Age 24 - Died of influenza and pneumonia. - Son of Fred and Ellen Wellstead of Donhead St. Andrew, nr Salisbury. Husband of Jane Wellstead of 42 Galloway Rd, Shepherd's Bush, London. Buried at Etaples Military Cemetery, Pad de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- LXV11. K. 7. Commemorated on Village War Memorial, Donhead St. Andrew
