




# St. Mary's Church

## Donhead St. Mary, Wiltshire

### Register of the Old and North Graveyards



This record was prepared by Brigadier Neville Pughe during the summer of 2007. This has been based on a previous register of uncertain date, possibly 1980, compiled and handwritten by Mr. Peter Ward, whose sources were partly a register made by the Rev. H.D. Peel (Rector 1941-1959) and partly a record kept by a former Sexton Mr. Frederick Briadle.

Verification has been achieved from all headstones where it has been possible to decipher the names on them. It has not been possible to determine the exact position of many graves where headstones have disappeared, may not have originally been provided or may have been moved in the course of churchyard maintenance over the years. Those graves that have positively been identified during the survey are annotated in the remarks column with the date of death. It is therefore possible to extrapolate between headstones in any given row to locate the approximate position of an unmarked grave.
