Redlynch, Downton *1800-1849*

1821

Committed to Fisherton Gaol. John Hayter, of Redlynch, labourer, charged with having stolen, on the night of the 2nd instant, a quantity of straw, the property of John Baily, at Redlynch. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 8 October 1821**

1833

Committed to Fisherton Gaol. George Moody, of Redlynch, Downton, charged with having on the 12th instant, maliciously cut and wounded Henry Bryant, with intent, &c. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, 21 November 1833**
