#### **Temperance Meeting**

A Temperance meeting was held in the School-room, on Tuesday evening, when the Rev. Mr Redhead delivered an excellent address, in which he did good service to the Temperance cause. Short but excellent addresses were also given by Mr Jacob Everly, Downton, (Primitive Methodist); Mr John Ings, Redlynch (Wesleyan); and Mr George Pearce, schoolmaster. It was a pleasing and interesting scene to witness the barrier of sectarian differences, which are so often detrimental to the progress of moral or religious reformation, thrown aside, and Churchmen and Dissenters earnestly united to oppose the great evil of our day – Intemperance.
