Death after Falling Down Stairs

An inquest was held by Mr Wilson, at Durrington, on Friday, on the body of Martha Poole. The deceased had gone on the Wednesday evening previous to nurse a neighbor, and fell down part of the stairs when leaving the bedroom. She was not sensible of any further injury than a blow on the nose and a sprained arm; but after she had retired to rest about an hour, the person with whom she slept was awoke by her stertorous breathing, and upon getting a light, she was discovered to be dead. From the medical evidence it appeared that she had most probably received a concussion of the brain, which led to apoplexy, of which she died. The deceased was 66 years of age, and was much respected by all who knew her.
