Insolvent Debtors' Court, Salisbury June 13

Wm. John Law, Esq., one of his Majesty's Commissioners, attended here on this day, when only three persons applied on their petitions to be discharged. Nothing occurred on this occasion, either interesting or important, no opposing creditor appearing in either case.

Matthew Rivers, late of Durrington, labourer, late in the employ of Mr Rowden, and who had been imprisoned on a judgement entered against him in an action of trespass, having been some time in prison, was at once discharged.
