Henry Head – Earlier Years

The 1861 Census recorded Henry Head as a 1 year old living (born Heddington, Wiltshire) at his Grandmother's house at Quemerford, Calne, Wiltshire. His grandmother was Mary Head (Widow, aged 62). Also listed was Ann Head, daughter of Mary & possibly Henry's mother (aged 30, Unmarried). Henry was one of 4 grandchildren listed – Clara Head (aged 10), John Head (aged 4), then Henry & Ann Head (aged 20). Also listed was William (aged 3 months, Great grandson of Mary Head).

The 1871 Census recorded Henry Head as an 11 year old Ploughboy living at his Grandmother's house at Cottage – Old Pike, Heddington, Wiltshire. His grandmother was Mary Head (Widow, aged 72). Also listed was Ann Head, daughter of Mary & possibly Henry's mother (aged 40, Unmarried). Henry was one of 5 grandchildren listed – John Head (Ploughboy, aged 14), then Henry, Gentella Head (aged 7), Frederick Head (aged 1) & William Head (aged 10 months).

The 1881 Census recorded Henry Head as a 21 year old, Agricultural Labourer, lodging with the Browne family at Durrington, Wiltshire. The Browne Family - Henry Browne (aged 27, Agricultural Labourer, born Headington), Harriet J. Browne (aged 22) & Fredrick J. Browne (aged 2, born Headington).
