



Killed By Runaway Wagon

Man pinned between wagon and wall

John Winchcombe, a farm hand of Easton Royal, near Burbage, Wilts., was killed when a horse attached to a wagon bolted last night.

The accident originated in a remarkable manner. The horse drawing the wagon was following a loose horse. This animal suddenly took fright and bolted, and the horse pulling the vehicle followed his example, the driver, Frederick Waite, being thrown out but not seriously injured.

The horse and wagon careered madly along to Manor Farm, where the animal belonged, and crashed into a wall. Later, Winchcombe was found pinned between the wagon and the wall.
