

Post Office Directory Extract 1855 Eisey



EISEY, with the tithing of WATER EATON, is a parish, 2 miles from Cricklade; it is in the Hundred of Highworth, Union and parliamentary borough of Cricklade and Wootton Bassett, North Wilts. The navigable river Thames passes through the parish. The extent of the Eisey tithing is 590 acres, and the population, in 1851, was 95; and of Water Eaton, 1,250 acres, with a population of 67. Here is an Episcopal chapel.

PORT FARM is 2 miles south-east.
