Etchilhampton, a tithing chapelry in All Cannings parish, Wiltshire, at the source of the Avon. 2½ miles South East of Devizes station on the Great Western Railway. Post town, Devizes. The area is included with the parish of All Cannings. The living is a chapelry, annexed to the rectory of All Cannings, in the diocese of Salisbury; joint net value, £850. Patron, Lord Ashburton. The church of All Saints, All Cannings, as well of St. Anne's, is mentioned in Domesday book, both then paying tribute to the Abbess of St. Mary, Winchester (See All Cannings)
