Etchilhampton

ETCHILHAMPTON is a tithing and village in the Swanborough Hundred, and the division and Union of Devizes, Salisbury bishopric, situated 3 miles east-by-south of Devizes. The tithing contains 916 acres of land, and a population of 258; for church purposes it is within the jurisdiction of the rector of the adjoining parish of All Cannings; in every other respect it is distinct. The church, a chapel of ease to the mother church at All Cannings, is a small but ancient structure, having a nave and chancel; there are 2 bells; the Rev. Thomas W. Cockell, M. A., is the curate, and resides at Stert. Here is a Free school. Lord Ashburton is lord of the manor.
