Everley Petty Sessions, Friday February 22 Before T.E. Fowle, Esq., and Major Heathcote. William Ward, late of Pewsey, was bought up on remand, charged with stealing, in company with another man, who was committed to the assizes upon the charge at a previous sessions, four tame pheasants from an aviary, the property of Mr J.
