Dyke	Elizabeth	This monument is erected and inscribed agreeably to the will of Mrs. Elizabeth Dike To the memory of Her much valued and lamented husband William Dyke, Esq. of Syrencot, in this Parish for many years an active and intelligent Magistrate for the County of Wilts He died on the 20th of May 1818, in the 75 th year of his Age and is buried in the vault beneath and this further inscription with affectionate decotion to the memory of both Parents lis added By Marianne Dyke and Edward Dyke Poore on whom devolved the duty of executing the directions of their Mother To record on the same Tablet her decease Mrs. Elizabeth Dyke was the elder daughter of the late George Webb Poore Esquire, of Devizes and departed this life at a very advanced age on the 17th of April 1838 and according to the desire she had expressed lies buried beside her husband

Dyke Efqr. of this Parish  She died deeply lamented by all who new her  on the 5th of March 1818 Æ 42  Alfo in the same grave lie buried  their two Children Samuel Rosser  who died April 20th 1816 Æ 12  and Elizabeth Arabella  who died June 30th 1818 Æ 12</p>
