1809

Preferment. Rev. William Williams of Fittleton to the vicarage of Netheravon, Wilts. Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 7 December 1809

1822

We are requested by a respectable gentleman, to state that the Rev. Dr. Parkinson, Rector of Fittleton in this county, has in the most liberal manner reduced the tithes of his parish 25 per cent, and has very generously promised to make a still further reduction next year should it be necessary. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 22 April 1822**

1841

Oxford: January 16. The President and Fellows of Magdalen College have presented the Rev. William Thomas Phillips, Fellow of their society, to the rectory of Fittleton, Wiltshire. **Morning Post Monday 18 January 1841**

The Rev. Wiliam Thomas Phillips, B.D., has been instituted by the Lord Bishop of Salisbury, to the Rectory of Fittleton in this county. (£467 a year), void by the death of John Parkinson D.D.
