St. Mary's Parish Church, Bury, has just been provided with two memorial brass tablets, to the memory of two former friends of Bury Grammar School, which adjoins the Parish Church. The following are the respective inscriptions:

“To the glory of God, in memory of the Rev. Roger Kay, MA., Rector of Fittleton and Prebendary of Salisbury. The founder of Bury Grammar School. He deceased March 1st 1730”

“To the glory of God, and in memory of the Very Rev. James Wood, DD, a pupil and benefactor of the Bury Grammar School, Dean of Ely and Master of St. John's College, Cambridge. He deceased April 23rd, 1839”.
