1769

16 March 1775

Thursday ye 16 of March 1775, the Revd. Richard Mant M.A. Master of the Free Grammar School in Southampton was Collated By the Bishop of Winchester to the Living of Bishops Fonthill in Wilts Void By the Cession of ye Revd Edmund Ferreis.

26 March 1775

And on Sunday 26 day of March 1775. The Revd. Richard Mant was Inducted and took Possession.

1811

When a general Census was taken throughout the United Kingdom, by Order of Government in June 1811, the Population of this Parish consisted of Two hundred and six souls – 98 males and 108 Females

1801

When a general Census was taken in 1891 the Amount of the Population was nearly the same.

1807
