

Coroners Inquest Report

Inquest on William True 1842

Held by George Sylvester, esq, at Fonthill Gifford, October 7th on William True aged 53. From the evidence of Thomas Wise, it appeared that the deceased and himself were employed during the night setting nets to catch rabbits; and on finishing about six o'clock in the morning, the deceased proceeded to the New Inn in Chicklade Bottom to get some beer. On his return he complained to Wise of uneasiness of his stomach, staggered, fell and instantly expired.

Verdict, 'Natural Death'.
