I Rechaurd Thomson of ffounthill Gifford on the County of Wilts Widow do this thirteenth day of July in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and fforty eight make and publish this Codicil to my last Will and Testament in manner following (that is to say)ffirst I give to my Sister Mrs Mary Thomson the sum of Ten pounds over and above the Ten pounds mentioned in my said Will Item I give to the Poor of the Parish of ffounthill Gifford the sum of six pounds and to the Poor of the Parish of ffounthill Bishop the sum of ffour pounds Item I give to my Neice Mrs Gardenor the sum of ffive pounds and the Childbed Linnen which was my late Husband's former Wife's Item I give unto my said Sister Mrs Mary Thomson my Crape Weed and black Pettycoat (the last I had made) And my Wedding Ring And it is my Will that the Ten pounds which I gave in my Will to Mrs Billinghurst's Children shall be applyed towards paying the Legacies herein mentioned I give unto my three Nieces (Daughters of the late Lady Heath) and my Neice Caverly ffive broad Silver peices each called King Edward's Shillings And it is my Will that my Executor shall bury me in a plain manner and I give unto the Revd Doctor Clifton the Revd Doctor Ballard the Revd Mr Willm Barford the Revd Mr Nairn the Revd Mr Thomas and the Curate of ffounthill Bishop a Silk Hattband and a pair of Gloves each and it is my desire that only the Revd Mr Nairn the Revd Mr Thomas and the Curate of ffounthill Bishop shall attend at my ffuneral And Lastly it is my desire that this my present Codicil be annexed and made a part of my last Will and Testament to all Intents and purposes In Witness whereof I have hereto sett my Hand and Seal the Day and Year above mentioned The mark of Rechaurd Thomson Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of us Wm Thomas_ Edward Lampard Wm Burnett
