James Haynes of Alderbury, and Daniel Hoare of Great Bedwin, for two months each, for breaches of the game laws. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 21 November 1833**

1843

Wilts Epiphany Sessions George Ducis, charged with having stolen four sovereigns, one shirt, one neckerchief, and one pocket handkerchief, the property of Charles Davis, at Great Bedwin. Guilty: 6 months imprisonment. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**

Thomas Hoare, John Ferris, and Maurice Stagg, charged with having stolen from the person of James Edwards, one knife, and one sovereign, the property of the said James Edwards, at Great Bedwin. Thomas Hoare, guilty: 6 months imprisonment, John Ferris and Maurice Stagg, no Bill. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
