1809

Death. At Stratton, near Cirencester, in his 76th year, the Rev. Clement Glynn, rector of Great Chalfield, Wiltshire. Oxford Journal 8 April 1809

1827

Wednesday, was married at Great Chalfield, Mr. Henry Neate, of Wick Down Farm near Marlborough, to Eliza, eldest daughter of Mr. Hulbert of Lenton.

1829
