| 1830 | Elizabeth Brown | One week for stealing two caps and some cotton at Hankerton
<i>Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 28 October 1830</i> |
| 1840 | John Matthews | Fined £2 and expenses, or two months imprisonment, for being found, late at night with a lurcher dog, in pursuit of game in the parish of Hankerton
