## 1841

Married April 17, at All Souls, Langham Place, London, by the Rev. William White, M.A., vicar of Stradbrooke, Suffolk, the Rev. William Maskelyne, M.A., rector of Crudwell and vicar of Hankerton, Wiltshire, and chaplain to the Earl de Grey, to Sarah, only surviving daughter of the late Rev. Thomas Wise, D.D., of Blandford, Dorset, and rector of Hagsworthingham, Lincolnshire.
