Married. At the Church of Holy Cross, Hankerton, on the 30th ult. by the Vicar. Old England, only son of Mr. John Goodson, of Aston Clinton, to Eliza Matilda, daughter of Mr. G Stevens, of Hankerton. **Bucks Herald, Saturday, 4 February 1905**

1906

Married April 28, at Holy Cross Church, Hankerton, by the Rev. F. J. W. Girling, James William, son of James Dutton, of Northleach, to Rosa Harding, daughter of Mrs Ellen Painter, of Hankerton.

1912
