Notice is hereby given, ----That we the undersigned Commissioners, appointed by and acting in execution of the Act of Parliament passed in the 48th year of the reign of his Majesty, for inclosing Lands in the parish of Hankerton, in the county of Wilts, intend to meet at the house of Richard Baker, called or known by the name or sign of the Horse and Groom Inn, at Charlton, in the said county, on Thursday the 24th day of August next, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, for the special purpose of reading over and executing the Award, by us made in pursuance of the said Act---when and where the several proprietors, and all other persons interested in the said inclosure, or any exchange in consequence thereof made, or who are otherwise concerned in the said award, may be present, if they so think proper.
