Newspaper Reports of the Courts Leet Meetings

1858 The Courts Leet for the parishes of Charlton and Hankerton were held on the 14th instant, before Mr W S Jones, as steward for the Earl of Suffolk. Officers were chosen and other business transacted, after which the juries and homage dined at the Horse and Groom Inn, at the former place, and passed a very agreeable evening
