We, the undersigned, being Landowners, within the parish of HANKERTON, including the hamlet of Cloatley, within the said parish, in the County of Wilts, whose Interest is not less than One-fourth part of the whole value of the lands subject to Tithes in the said Parish, do, by this Notice in writing, under our hands, call a PAROCHIAL MEETING of Landowners and Titheowners, within the said Parish, for the purpose of making an Agreement for the purpose of making an Agreement for the General COMMUTATION of TITHES within the limits of the said Parish, pursuant to, the provisions of an Act passed in the sixth and seventh years of the reign of his late Majesty King William the fourth, intituled "An Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England"; - and we do hereby also give notice, that such Meetings will be held in the Parish Church of Hankerton aforesaid, on Tuesday, the 24th day of July 1838, at the hour of Eleven o' clock in the Forenoon.
