Memorandum That on or about the five and twentieth day of September in the yeare of our Lord God One thousand six hundred seventy one **Alice Gagg** late of Hankerton in the Countie of Wiltes widdow deceased being then of perfect mind and memorie, did make and declare her last Will & Testam^t  or by word of mouth in manner and forme following (vizs)

I give all my Estate whatsoever unto **Alice Hodges** the wife of **William Hodges** of Bitton in the Countie of Gloucester gent, whome I make sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament which words or words to the same effect she the said deceased uttered and spoke with an intent and purpose that they should stand for and be her last Will and Testament in the Presence and hearing of **Alice Gagg** and **Margaret** the wife of **John Curtis**.
