



Council of Ecclesiastical Commissioners

An Order in Council of the 15th ultimate ratifies a scheme prepared by the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England for making additional provision for the cure of souls in certain parishes, where such assistance is most needed. We perceive by the order in question that the Perpetual Curacies of Heytesbury and Knook, in this county are to receive two several grants of £140 and £60, arising out of property within the above parishes, now actually vested in the commissioners.
